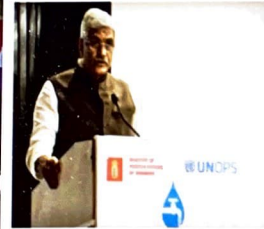

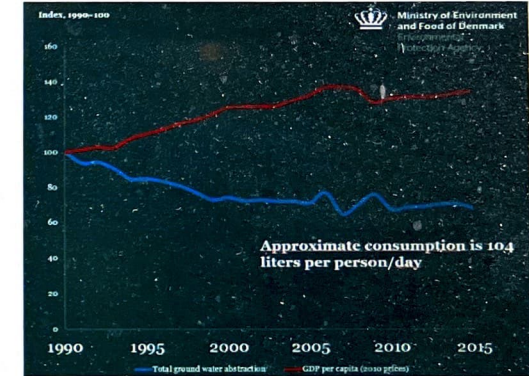
Quadruple Helix model



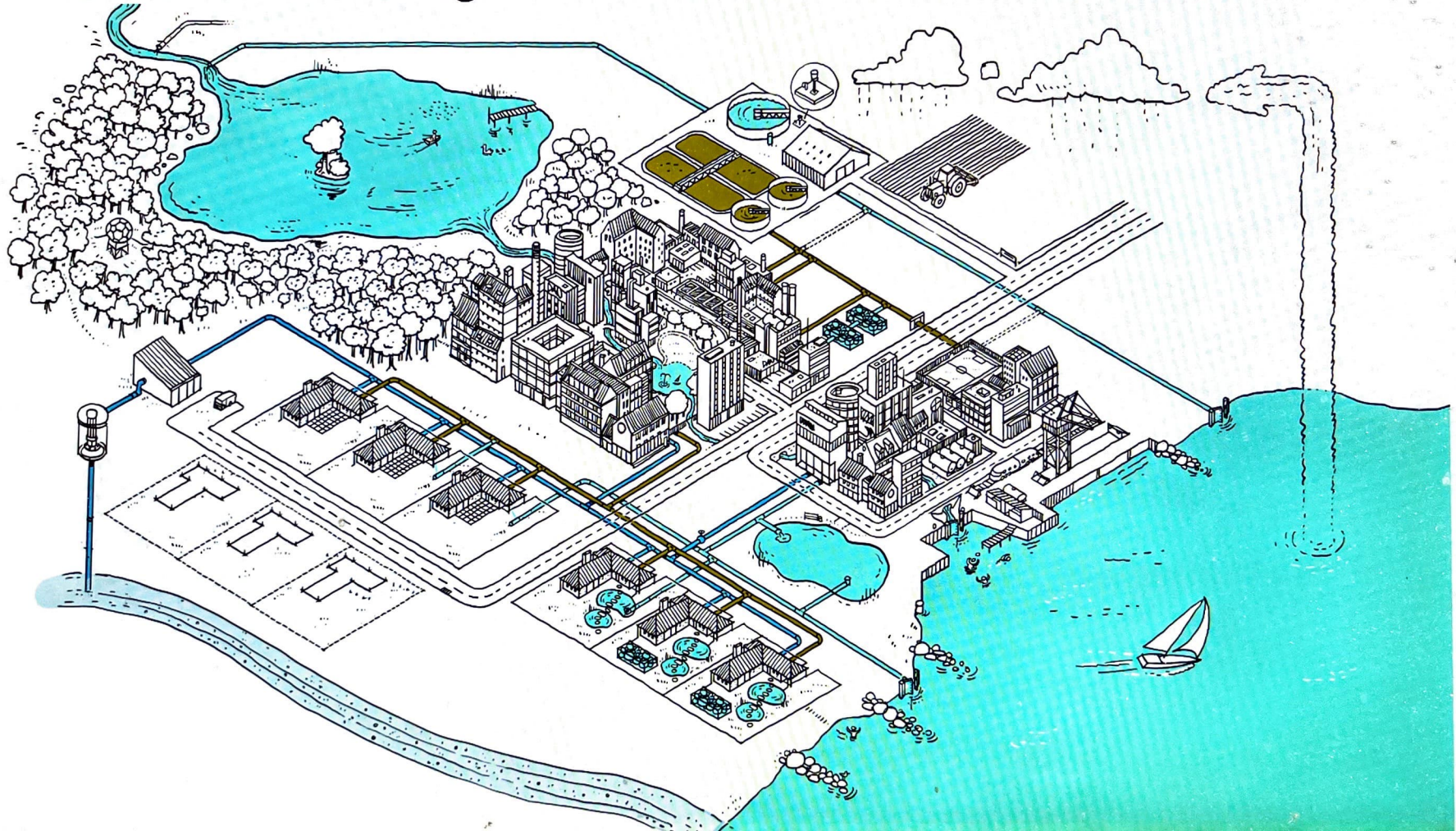
